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Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

Anaheim University was established as a unique, innovative and sustainable institution of higher learning to meet the educational needs of a diverse and global student body through academic programs of the highest quality. Dedicated to a student-centered philosophy, Anaheim University makes higher education accessible to qualified students worldwide through both online and on-campus study.

Anaheim University specializes in undergraduate and graduate programs in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL); graduate business programs in sustainability, international business, entrepreneurship, and management; and film, with both an MFA in Digital Filmmaking and a BA in Communications Completion Program with a concentration in Film and Entertainment.

Anaheim University monitors student achievement through ongoing assessment of course work, course completion, program completion, and satisfaction rates, among other markers. The interactive discussion forums and live, synchronous classes offer a high-quality education that meets the needs of a global student population that might not otherwise have access to these programs or be able to put their lives on hold to study. The achievement of the mission is demonstrated through Anaheim's 2022 graduation and 2023 student satisfaction rates, which are based on cohorts calculated within 100% of the normal completion time.

Aggregated Institutional Data on Student Achievement

In 2022, Anaheim's non-degree programs exceeded the DEAC's graduation benchmark of 60% with a graduation rate of 92.3%. The master's degree programs did not meet the DEAC's graduation benchmark of 54% with a graduation rate of 33.3%. The doctoral degree programs met the DEAC's graduation benchmark of 40% with a graduation rate of 44.3%.
