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Summary of Institution Mission and Student Achievement

Mission: Anaheim University was established as a unique, innovative and sustainable institution of higher learning to meet the educational needs of a diverse and global student body through academic programs of the highest quality. Dedicated to a student-centered philosophy, Anaheim University makes higher education accessible to qualified students worldwide through both online and on-campus study.

Anaheim offers online programs in English teacher education, business administration, international business, sustainable management, entrepreneurship, and digital filmmaking. The University’s interactive discussion forums and live, synchronous classes offer a high-quality education that meets the needs of a global student population that might not otherwise have access to these programs or be able to put their lives on hold to study. Anaheim’s graduate school professors all hold terminal degrees and are at the top of their respective fields, and they help drive the student-centered philosophy that keeps the best interests of students at the heart of Anaheim’s “Students First, Always” motto.

The achievement of both this mission and motto is demonstrated through Anaheim’s graduation rates and through the number of alumni who report being employed in the field upon completion of their programs.

Anaheim University students are determined to have graduated when they have completed the total number of required credits or hours for their programs; earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (or 70% or higher for the TESOL Certificate, TEYL Certificate, and Undergraduate Diploma in TESOL programs); and successfully completed their capstone, thesis, or dissertation project if required for their program.
